 For the fourth year, our foundation is continuing its efforts in the field of humanitarian work with a high level of loyalty and professionalism.
 The foundation pursues to development, distinction and pioneering in providing its humanitarian services, with a main focus on building the capacity of human capital.

A short journey counted by hours and days, but full of accomplishments and challenges, which built our strength and provided us with more insistence to assist our community and the whole humanity.

In **23 /5 /2012** Field Medical Foundation was established and promoted to an official local foundation in the field of humanitarian work. Since then, we have been focusing on attracting the specialized human resources in all fields and expertise, and at the same time building the capacity of the human resources of our employees as well as our volunteers. By benefiting for our administrative and technical experiences, FMF has been able to develop its institutional structure, and embrace high standards of quality in service provision that enabled us to

reach to the level of international organizations.
 In FMF we are proud of our donors and partners in developments, Their efforts have contributed to a great extent in the development of FMF and the scope of its humanitarian work. Also, the foundation is proud and grateful to the role of the government that is providing the constant support and facilitate the procedures to the local NGOs , so as they will be able to serve the communities without difficulty.

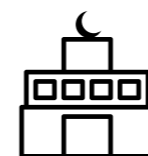

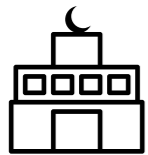

The second Taibah campaign for medical relief was aiming to provide the medical centers, which suffered from a huge burden as a result of war, with medicines and medical equipment.

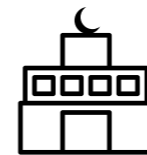

CLEANING AND REARRANGEMENT OF THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE – ADEN UNIVERSITY AFTER WAR

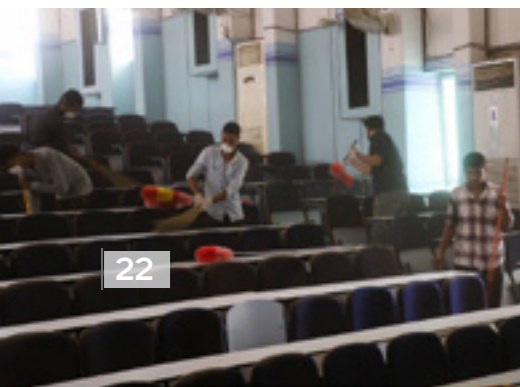
