## OPENING WORDS BY FMF CHAIRMAN

Years are passing and the humanitarian crisis in Yemen keeps worsening. With this deteriorating situation, the urgent need for relief has been increasing, which places huge responsibility on the state and the different NGOs to find solutions for different issues such as malnutrition, food insecurity, deteriorating WASH services, spreading of diseases and epidemics, weak economy and income, huge influx of IDPs from conflicting areas and the multiple violation of women and children rights. .

As a response to these huge challenges, FMF as one of the key NGOs, has to expand its areas of interventions in the relief and development. The expansion was based on the efficiency and professionalism of its staff and their determination to assist and reach the people in need.

FMF has managed to access and serve the ones in need through its 9 offices at different governorates, and its more than 1500 staff, in addition to a large network of community volunteers.

FMF has also managed to access and serve through its soiled partnerships with local authorities, UN agencies, INGOs and NGOs. Through these partnerships, FMF was able to expand its scope of work to further support the treatment of malnutrition through health facilities, mobile clinics and communication for development programme. Also, FMF has been able to support food security by distributing more than 50,000 food baskets per month. In addition, FMF has supported early recovery interventions in livelihood sector through supporting small farmers with crops, poultry, and livestock that empowered the targeted families economically and enhanced their living conditions.

FMF has also intervened in supporting RH services through capacity building for hospitals and health centers, and supporting staff incentives and technical equipment.

In addition, FMF has intervened in the different aspects in protection, especially for the IDPs, marginalized groups and host communities. The intervention has had a great impact on increasing the awareness of the targeted

groups regarding protection and rights, and engaged the targeted groups in detecting, awareness and referral tools. Moreover, FMF has also supported health and administrative centers with modern medical equipment and supported the capacity building for the health staff on health issues and best health practices.

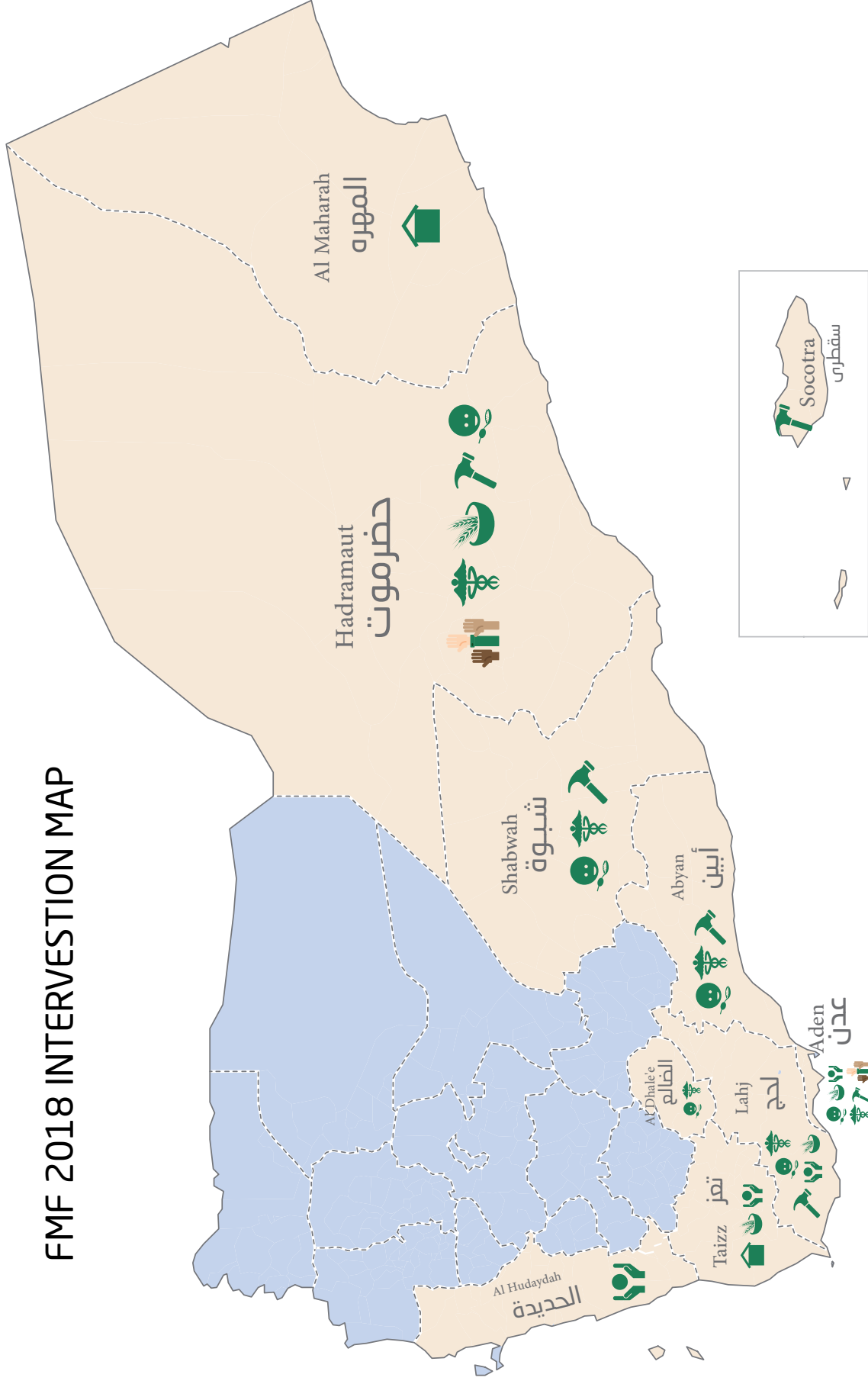
2018 has been the year for expanding and empowering the partnership with ministries, local authorities, UN agencies and INGOs.

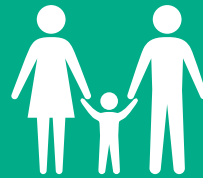

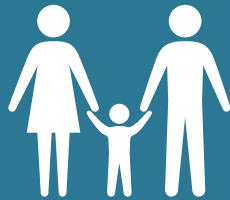

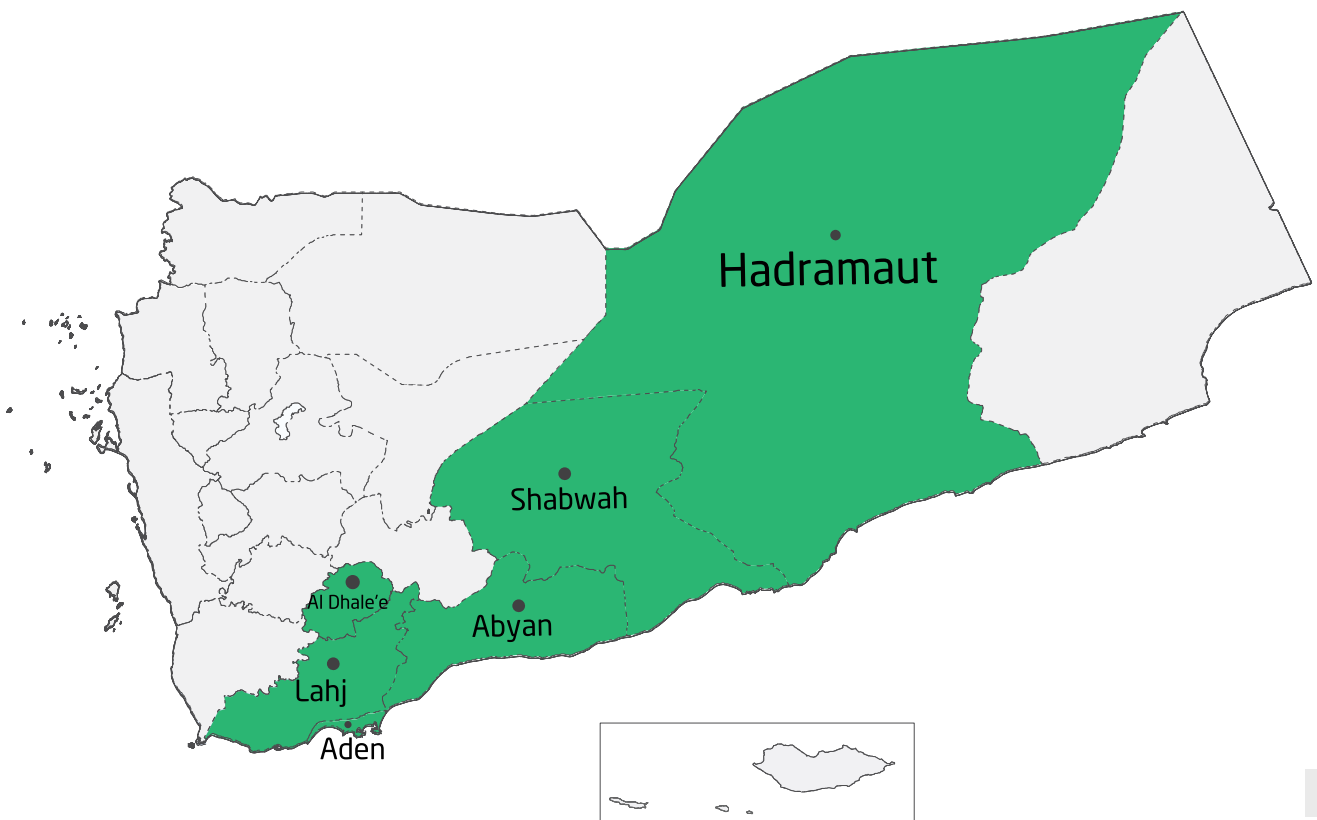

### MAP OF FMF INTERVENTION

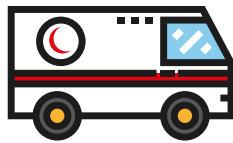


## Integrated Nutrition Project Funded by UNICEF

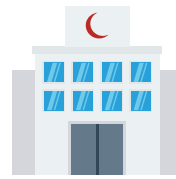
The Integrated Nutrition Project aims to reduce morbidity and mortality rates among children under five years of age, and pregnant and lactating women by through reaching those groups in three of Yemen most vulnerable governorates (Abyan, Al-Dhale'a and Shabwa). Despite the geographical distance Remoteness of the operational areas, security challenges and its closeness to the front lines, we have reached the majority of beneficiaries through our medical and nutrition team to provide lifesaving humanitarian services to the targeted groups of children under 5 years and pregnant and lactating women.

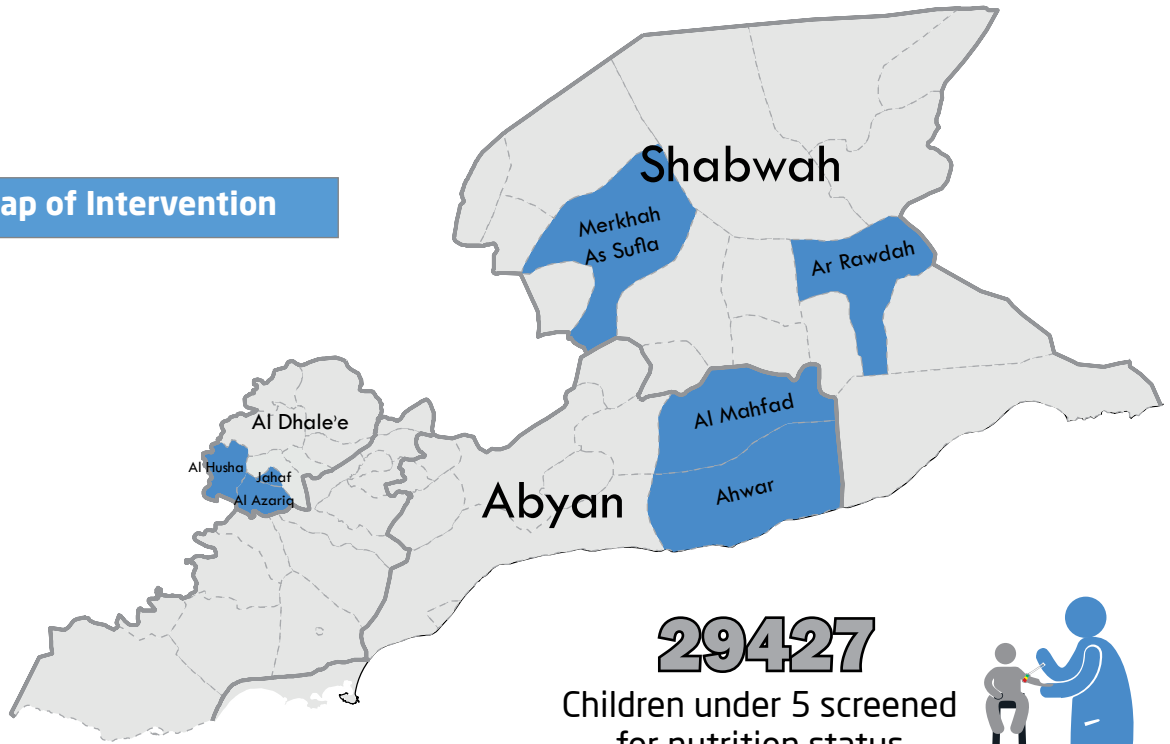

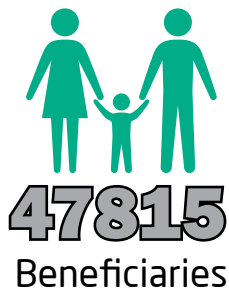
## Food Security Program Funded by WFP

The current level of hunger in Yemen is unprecedented and causing severe hardship for millions of people. Now, 20 million people in the country are food insecure, meaning they do not have enough food. Of these, 9.6 million - that is almost one in four people - are severely food insecure and rely entirely on external assistance. The rate of child malnutrition is one of the highest in the world.

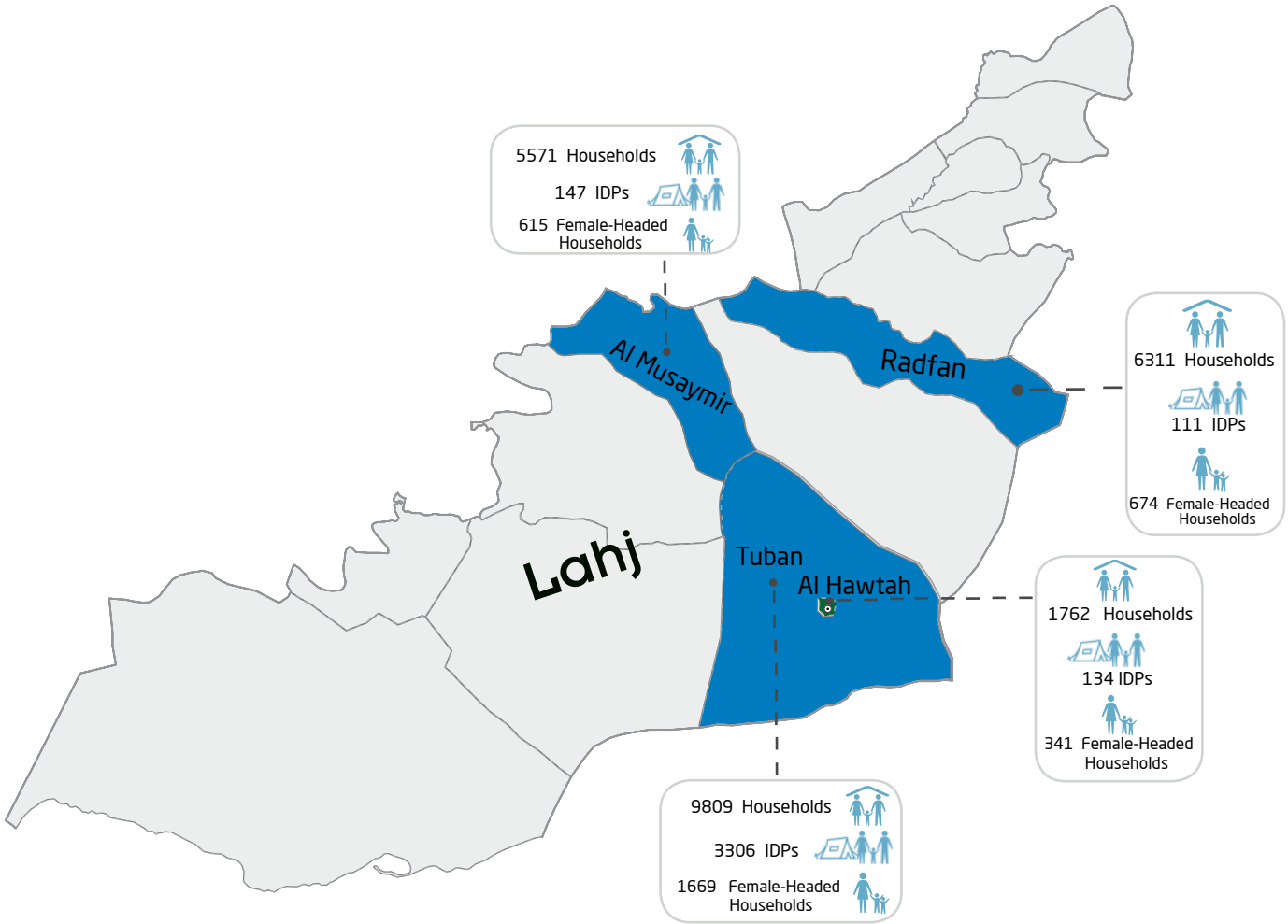
WFP, in partnership with the FMF, is working to reduce the risk of food insecurity for families in Lahj, Hadhramout and Taiz.

### Targeting Criteria:

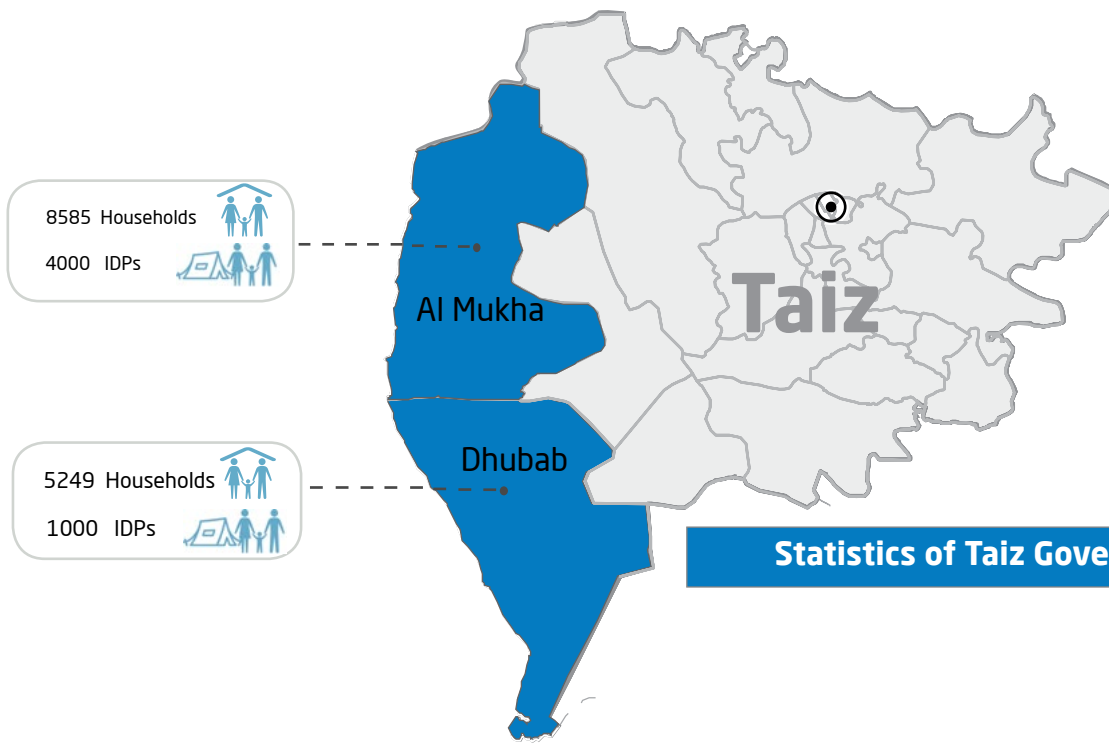
- Households with children under five years registered in curative activities for SAM or MAM.
- IDPs living in public camps, shelters, without sources of income and no means of accessing food.
- Households from socially and economically marginalized communities (mohamasheen) who do not have any sources of food.
- Households headed by females/widowed who live independently with their children and have no means of income.
- Vulnerable households headed by physically challenged persons and chronically ill persons without bread winners.
- Child-headed households who have no income and means of accessing food.



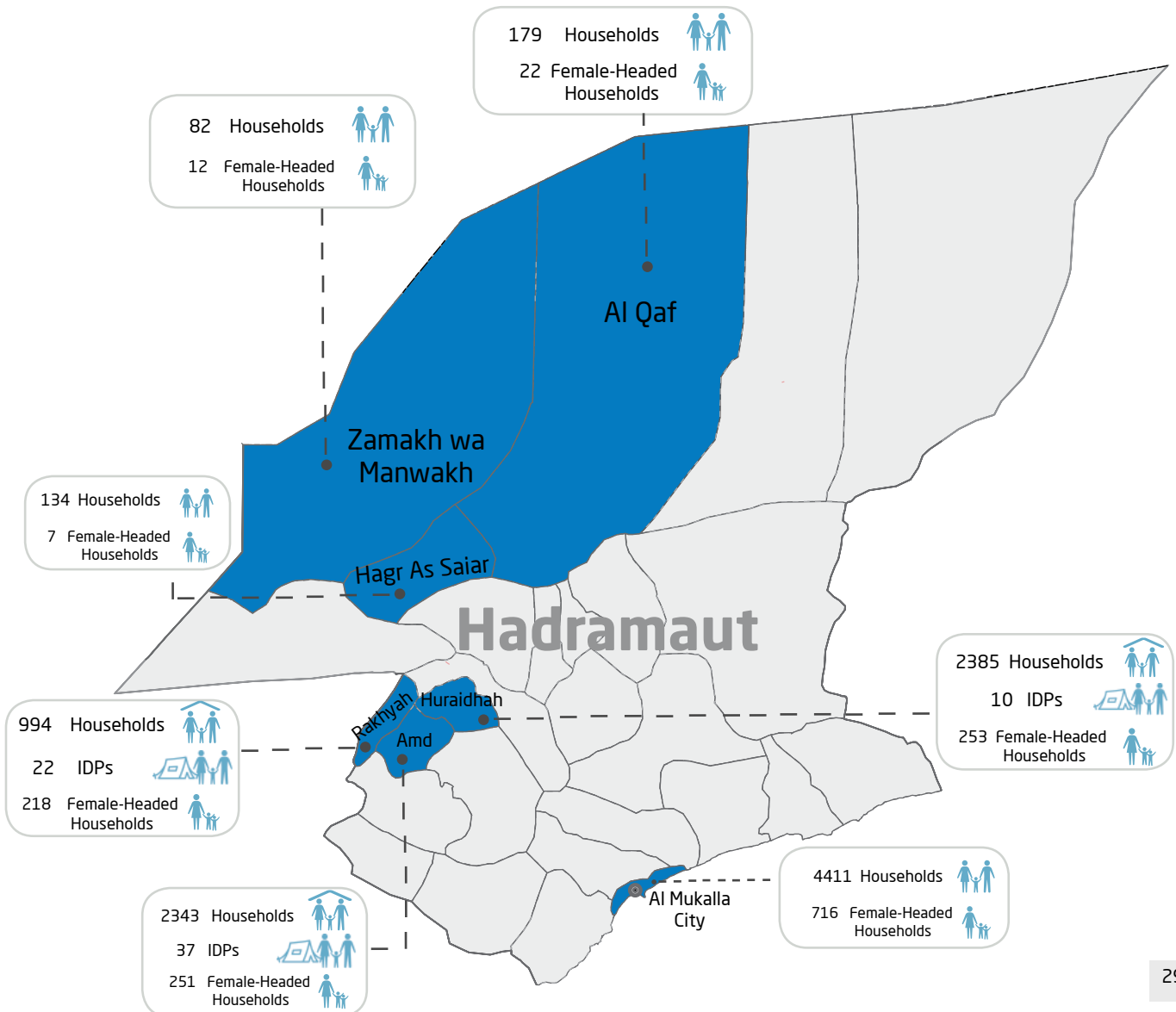

Under this project Strengthening protection response and prevention services in humanitarian setting through well-established Community Based Protection Network in 8 districts of Taiz, Aden and Lahj governorates, Yemen.

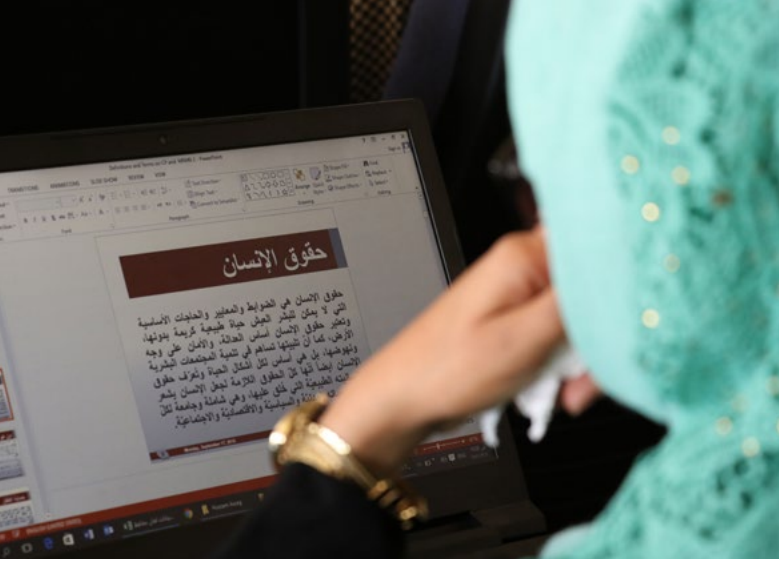
FMF has established 44 CBPNs that include 440 members, where they received training to build their capacity in the principles of protection, child protection, gender-based violence, first psychological aid and the principles of peaceful coexistence.

FMF prepared a comprehensive services mapping that provide full information about humanitarian assistance at the targeted areas, there were 206 humanitarian services in the sectors of protection, child protection, health, nutrition, FSL, education, social solidarity, WASH, gender-based violence and shelter to facilitate the referral of vulnerable cases to service providers.

In addition to provide community awareness sessions and monitoring community issues for Internal Displaced People, Host Community and Refugees.

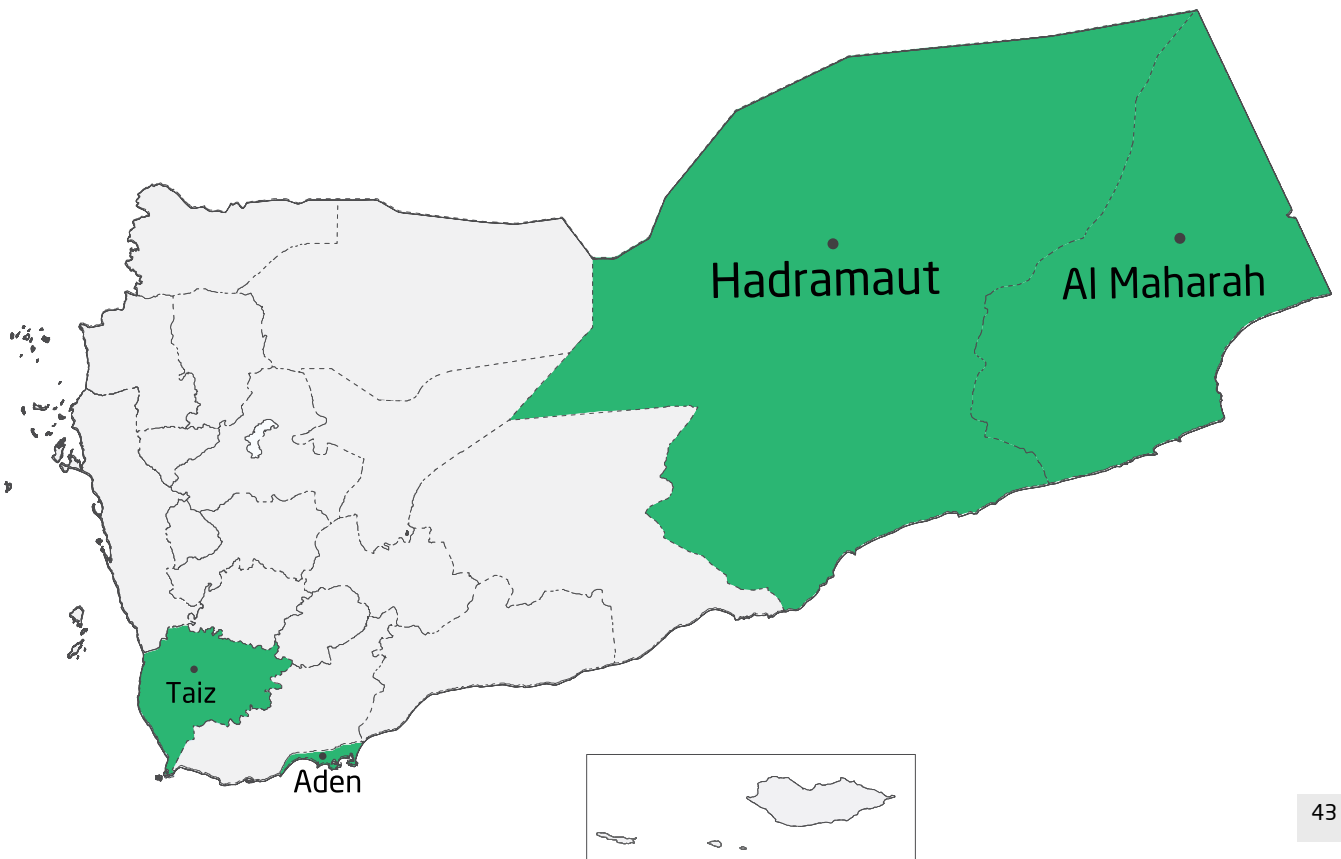

## Rapid Response Mechanism RRM

The ongoing conflict in the West Coast and other locations has led to an increase in poverty among the population, especially with the ongoing displacements and interruption of basic services. The situation has recently further escalated in Hodeida after June 2018, leading to a displacement of 450,000 persons, where most of the families left their homes to the southern governorates seeking for food security and safety.

Rapid Response Mechanism (RRM) Project:

RRM is one of the first emergency response interventions for newly arrived IDPs its aimed to distribute emergency kits to families who are newly displaced or in hard-to-reach areas or stranded close to the front lines. RRM will be for the initial period of the onset of the emergency to cover the immediate needs for the first seven days of displacement.

### RRM Components:

- Basic Hygiene kit
- Hygiene kit
- Female dignity Kits
- High Energy Biscuits
- IRR

The Field Medical Foundation began distributing emergency kits in the Mukhaa and Dhubab districts during the period from July to December, funded by ( WFP, UNFPA )



## Relief for the Family Affected by Luban Cyclone Funded by FMF

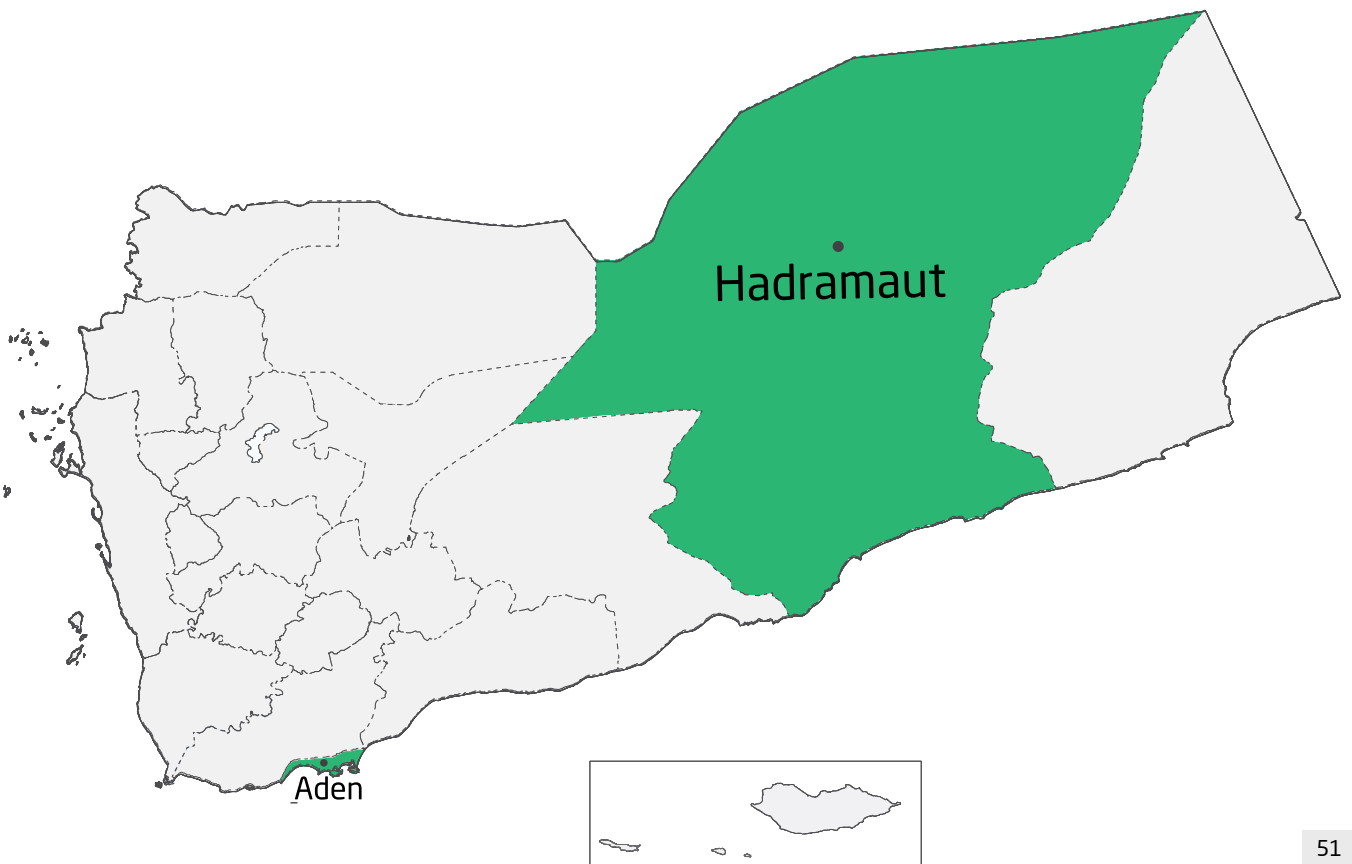
